What is Charin?

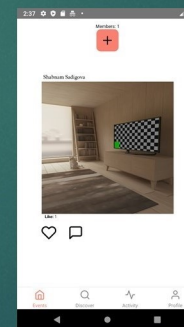
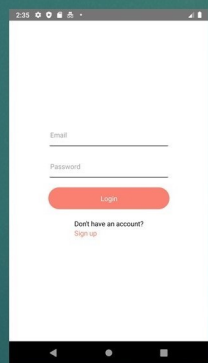
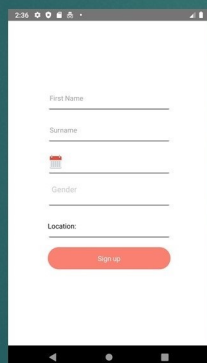
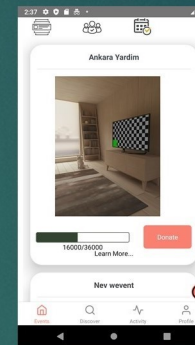
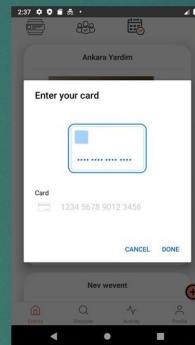
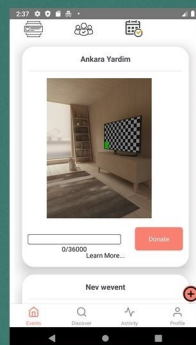
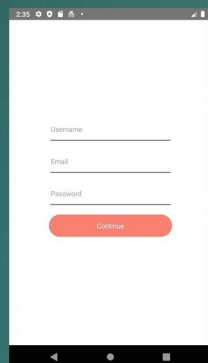
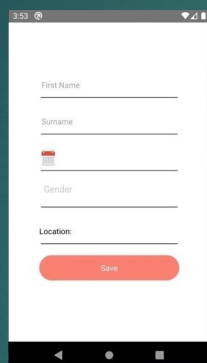
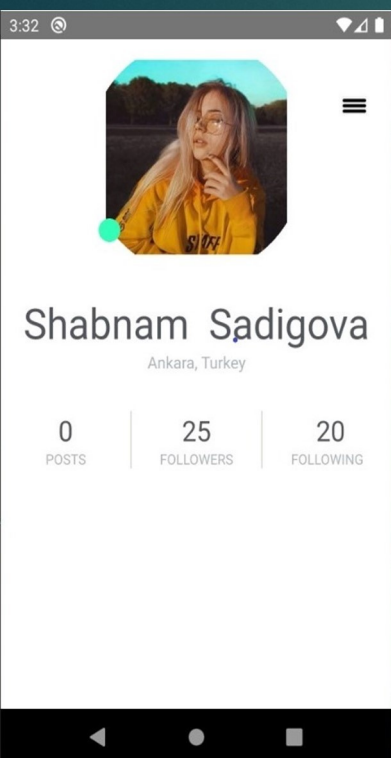
