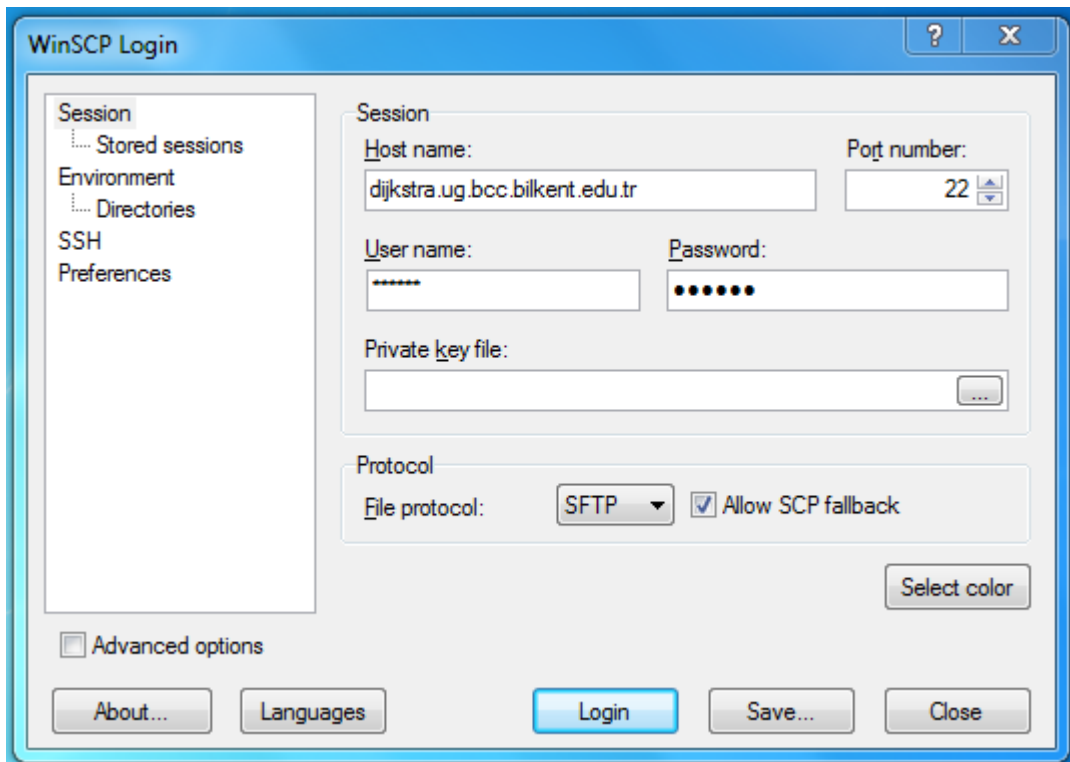


Dijkstra Guide

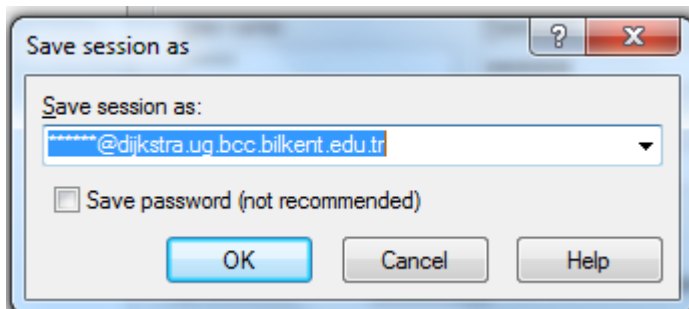
In your homeworks, most of the time you'll need to log in to dijkstra and run your code. A good dijkstra tutorial is available at http://www.cs.bilkent.edu.tr/~tosun/CS201_Linux_tutorial.htm.

If you need to upload a file to dijkstra (or download a file) you might need an ftp client to access your directory in dijkstra machine. The tutorial shows some way to do this, but I would like to mention another way to do this. There is software called "winscp" which is a free ftp client, and it is easy to use.

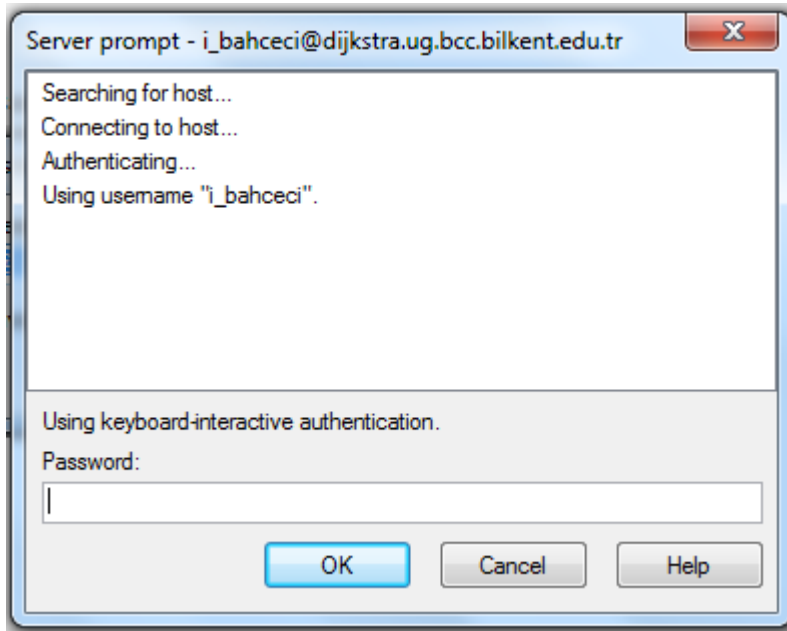
1. You first need to download and install the software from its website <http://winscp.net/eng/index.php>
2. You enter the host name, which is in our case, dijkstra.ug.bcc.bilkent.edu.tr



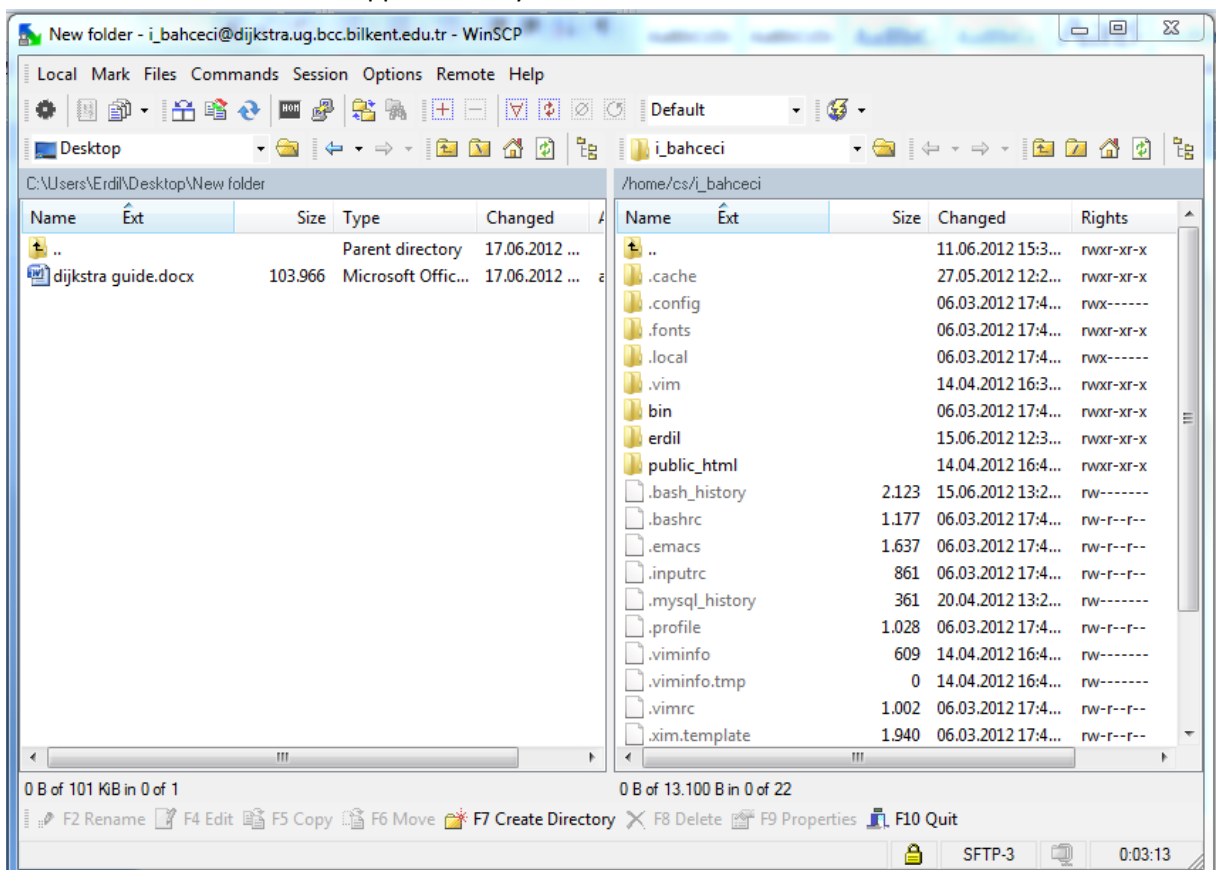
3. You can save it for later use



- Then select your saved session and click login a pop-up will appear asking your password, enter it.



- Two different directories will appear side by side.



On the left-hand side, you see your local computer, and on the right hand side, you see your ftp server, which in our case dijkstra machine. You can simply drag and drop your files from one side to another.
